Role of a Paramedical Technician

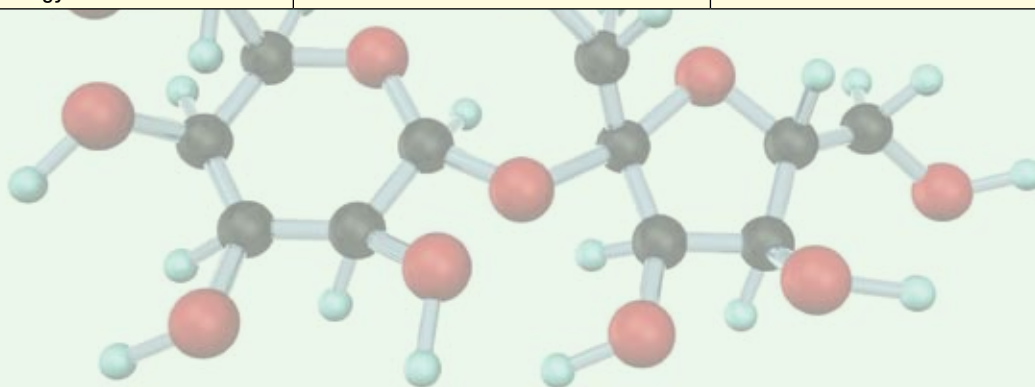
The role is to assist doctors to provide the correct diagnosis of a disease to enable its best possible treatment. And therefore paramedical sciences have their own value and significance.
